Power of Attorney is granted:

1. For conducting litigation (including pursuant to Sections 81 et seq. ZPO), including the authority to file and withdraw counterclaims;
2. For filing motions in divorce and ancillary divorce matters, concluding agreements on ancillary divorce matters, and filing motions for the granting of pension and other supply information;
3. For representation and defense in criminal and administrative offense cases (Sections 302, 374 StPO) including preliminary proceedings and (in case of absence) representation pursuant to Section 329 StPO and Section 411 II StPO, with express authorization also pursuant to Sections 233 I, 234 StPO, for filing criminal and other motions permissible under the Code of Criminal Procedure, and motions under the Law on Compensation for Criminal Prosecution Measures, in particular for the sum proceedings;
4. For representation in other proceedings and out-of-court negotiations of all kinds (in particular in accident cases to assert claims against tortfeasors, vehicle owners, and their insurers);
5. For establishing and terminating contractual relationships and for making and receiving unilateral declarations of intent (e.g., notices of termination) in connection with the matter mentioned above under "regarding..."

The Power of Attorney initially applies in consultation with the client for the out-of-court area and also extends to all judicial instances as well as ancillary and subsequent proceedings of all kinds (e.g., arrest and temporary injunctions, cost assessment, compulsory enforcement, intervention, compulsory auction, compulsory administration, and deposit proceedings, as well as insolvency proceedings over the opponent's assets). It particularly includes the authority to effect and receive service of process, to transfer the Power of Attorney wholly or partially to others (sub-power of attorney), to file, withdraw, or waive legal remedies, to settle the legal dispute or out-of-court negotiations by settlement, waiver, or acknowledgment, to receive money, valuables, and documents, in particular the object of the dispute and the amounts to be refunded by the opponent, the judicial treasury, or other bodies, and to inspect the files.

The client has been informed in accordance with the scope of Section 2 Paragraph 1 of the Lawyers' Compensation Act (RVG) that the fees for legal representation in civil law matters are calculated based on the value of the matter in dispute.
